Bursary Value

- **5 bursaries available**
- Each bursary valued at **R20,000 per student**

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must:

- Be a **dependent child of a permanent Cerebos Group employee**
- The parent/guardian must be a **permanent employee earning below the prescribed earnings threshold** as determined in terms of the Basic Conditions of Employment Act (commonly referred to as the LRA threshold)
- Be **between the ages of 18 and 35**
- Be **unemployed**
- Be **accepted or registered at an accredited University or TVET College**

All **fields of study** are eligible for this bursary.

Important Information

- Only **one beneficiary per employee** may be awarded a bursary.
- Applicants receiving other funding (e.g. **NSFAS**) may still apply but must **declare all financial assistance**.
- To maintain funding, students must pass **at least 80% of their registered modules**.
